FIRST AWARDED IN
1893



NHL FINALS

STANLEY CUP TROPHY

Named after Lord Stanley of Preston, the Governor General of Canada at the time

Current version of the trophy was designed and released in 1948

The trophy consists of a bowl, three tiered bands, a collar, and five barrel or uniform bands

The trophy is 35.25 inches tall and weighs 34.5 pounds

SUPER BOWL

LOMBARDI TROPHY

Designed by Tiffany & Co.

First awarded to Green Bay Packers in 1967

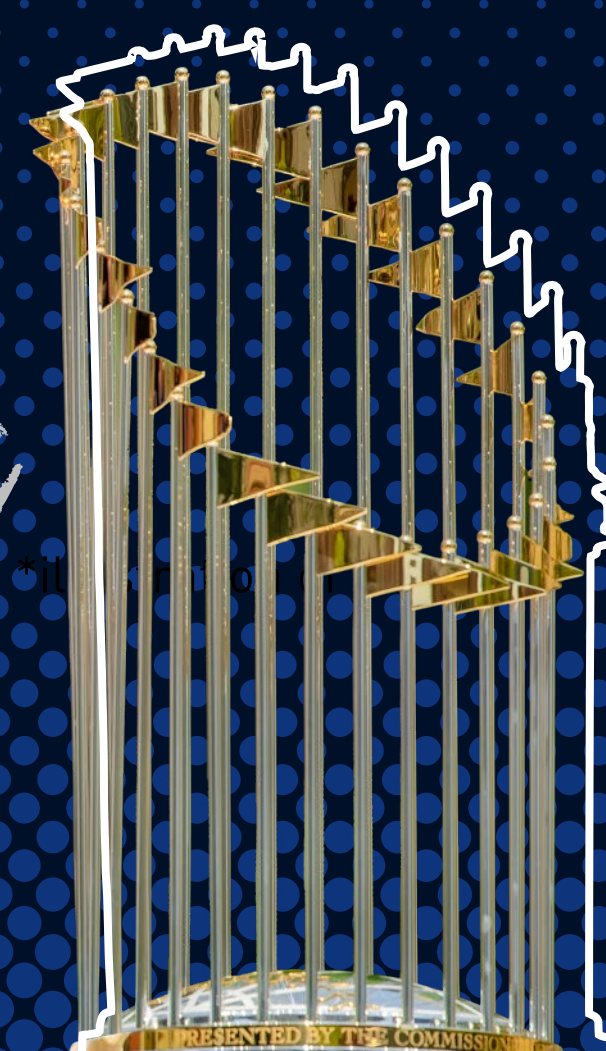
Originally named the World Professional Football Championship Trophy

Renamed the Lombardi Trophy in 1970 after Vince Lombardi passed away

The trophy consists of a football in the kicking position on a three concave-sided stand

The trophy is 20 inches tall and weighs 8.75 pounds

COMMISSIONER'S TROPHY

Original 1967 trophy designed by Balfour Jewelers

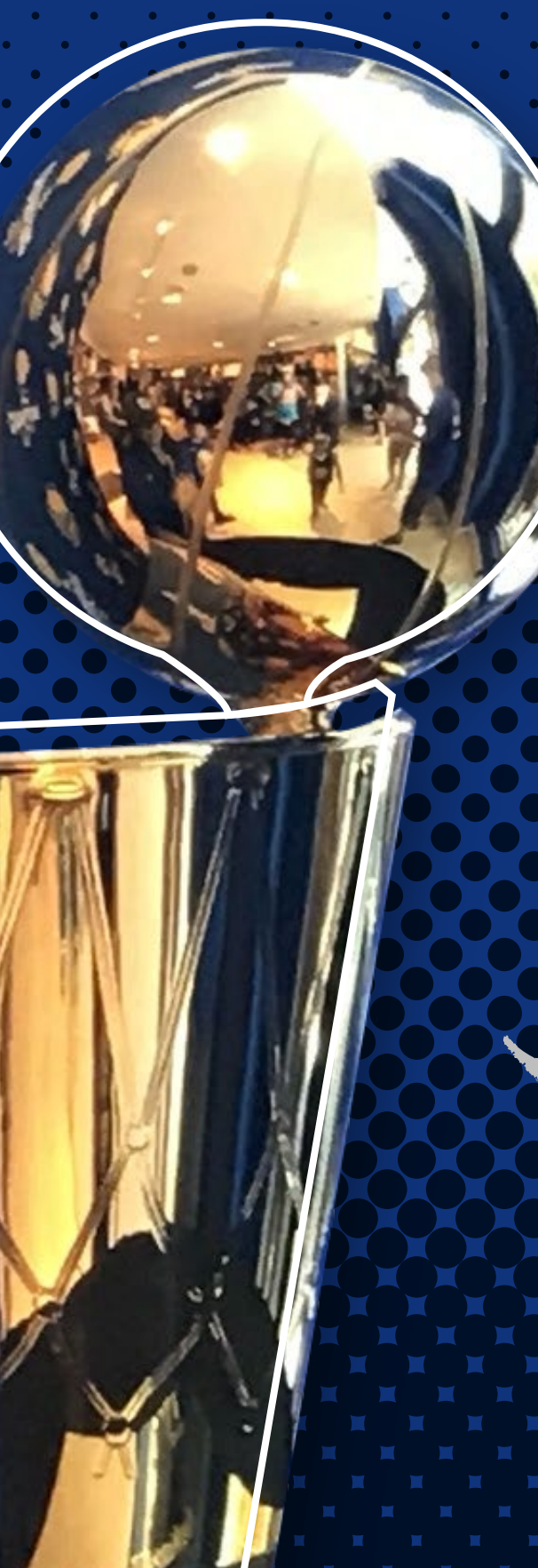
First awarded to St. Louis Cardinals in 1967

Current trophy designed by Tiffany & Co. in 2000

The trophy consists of 30 flags, one for each Major League team

The trophy is 24 inches tall and weighs 20 pounds

NBA FINALS

LARRY O'BRIEN CHAMPIONSHIP TROPHY

Designed by Tiffany & Co.

Originally named Walter A. Brown Trophy

First awarded to Portland Trailblazers in 1977

Renamed Larry O'Brien Trophy after NBA commissioner in 1984

Redesigned by Victor Solomon and Tiffany & Co. 2022

The trophy consists of a circular base with a regulation-sized basketball and net

The basketball and net are slanted forward to represent the league's progressiveness

The trophy is 25.5 inches tall and weighs 29 pounds
